VILLAGE OF DEBDEN
PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN

BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE CLOSING OF CERTAIN STREETS:

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Urban Municipality Act, 1978, the Village of Deben, in the Province of Saskatchewan, may open and close any Public Highways:

AND WHEREAS the Council for the Village of Deben desires to close all of the following:

FIRSTLY:

"ALL of Second Avenue West, as shown on a plan of record in the Land Titles Office for the Prince Albert Land Registration District as Number CP 5226."

SECONDLY:

"ALL of Second Avenue West as shown on a plan of survey of record in the Land Titles Office for the Prince Albert Land Registration District as Number 78-PA-19546."

THIRDLY:

"ALL of Second Street North lying to the north-east of the production north westerly of the South-West Boundary of Public Reserve R2, as shown on a plan of survey of record in the Land Titles Office for the Prince Albert Land Registration District as Number AK 1413, and lying south-west of a straight line between Iron Post R3 and R2A as shown on a plan of record in the Land Titles Office for the Prince Albert Land Registration District as Number 74-PA-20115."

AND WHEREAS the Minister of Highways and Transportation for the Province of Saskatchewan has granted his consent;

NOW THEREFORE the Council for the Village of Deben, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) Under the authority and by virtue of Section 147 of the Urban Municipality Act, 1978, the Council of the Village of Deben, in the Province of Saskatchewan, DO DECLARE AS CLOSED AND ABANDONED, THE ABOVE DESCRIBED STREETS.
- (2) This Bylaw shall come into force on the date of the final passing thereof.

INTRODUCED AND READ in Council a first time the 17 day of May, A.D. 1984.

READ A SECOND TIME this 17 day of May, A.D. 1984.

READ A THIRD TIME and finally passed by the Council as voted on by members of Council this 17 day of May, A.D. 1984.

The Petition of the Council for the Village of
Debden, in the Province of Saskatchewan, Dominion of Canada,
SHOWETH:

- (1) THAT Her Majesty the Queen in the Right of Her
Province of Saskatchewan, as represented by the
Saskatchewan Urban Affairs, is the vested owner
of the following:

"ALL THAT PORTION of Public Reserve R₂, as shown
on a plan of record in the Prince Albert Land
Registration District as Number AK 1413."

- (2) THAT the Village of Debden is desirous of
redesignating the said described land in order
to effect a new plan of survey.
- (3) THAT produced herewith is the transfer to the
Village of Debden from Saskatchewan Urban Affairs.

WHEREFORE your Petitioners pray that the Master
of Titles do issue an order directing:

- (A) THAT the said plan numbered AK 1413 be amended
by redesignating the above described lands.
- (B) THAT a new Certificate of Title and Duplicate
thereof do issue in the name of "Village of Debden,
Box 400, Debden, Saskatchewan, SOJ OSO", for
the above mentioned land so redesignated.
- (C) THAT such other things be done that the Master
of Titles deems necessary.
