

A BYLAW TO EXEMPT ALL STORES FROM HOLIDAY CLOSING.

THE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF DEBDEN IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN,
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS;

INTERPRETATION:

1. In this bylaw, the word

"closed" means not open for;

- i) the serving of customers or the receiving of orders from customers;
- ii) admitting members of the public or any category of the public.

"day" means any twenty four hour period commencing at 12:00 midnight.

"holiday" means New Year's Day, Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Victoria Day, Thanksgiving Day, Remembrance Day, Christmas Day, and any day or a part of a day:

- i) prescribed as a holiday by any Act other than The Urban Municipality Act, 1984 or an Act of Parliament of Canada;
- ii) declared as a holiday by the Lieutenant Governor in Council;
- iii) proclaimed a Civic holiday pursuant to Section 170 of The Urban Municipality Act, 1984.

"store" means any building or portion of a building, booth, stall or other place where goods are exposed or offered for sale or auction;

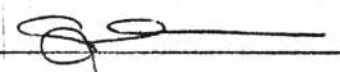
"open" means open for;

- i) serving of customers to the receiving or orders from customers;
- ii) admitting members of the public or any category of the public;
