

## Bylaw 14/2017

### A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Village of Debden in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
  - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
  - b) "Municipality" shall mean the Village of Debden
  
2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service in accordance with:
  - Schedule "A" which is attached to and forming a part of this bylaw.
  - That the property owner will be responsible for any costs incurred by call of any other resources deemed necessary by the Debden Fire Chief.
  
3. The Fire Truck Fee will not be assessed on reasonably established false alarm calls; however the Fire Fighter hourly rate will apply.
  
4. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year or 30 days after the person has been invoiced for said services, whichever is earlier.
  
5. Bylaw 10/2013 is hereby repealed.
