BYLAW NO. 1/2020

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF DEBDEN TO ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION

The council for the Village of Debden, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Emergency Measures Organization Bylaw.
- 2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to establish a Local Emergency Measures Organization to deal with any emergency or disaster that may occur.

REGULATIONS

- 3. The Village Council shall appoint a person as Local Emergency Coordinator.
- 4. The Village Council shall establish a Local Emergency Planning Committee composed of:
 - a. The Local Emergency Coordinator appointed in Section 2;
 - b. Two (2) or more Council members appointed by resolution of Council; And
 - c. Any such other persons deemed necessary.
- 5. The Emergency Coordinator is the Chairperson of the Emergency Planning Committee.
- 6. The EMO Coordinator may be paid a monthly stipend, as well as a fee per hour. Such amounts to be determined by Council and may be amended from time to time.
- 7. The Village of Debden shall provide funding as deemed necessary and appropriate in the establishment and maintenance of the Emergency Measures Organization.
- 8. The Council may enter into agreements with other Municipalities for the purpose of jointly establishing and operating a Mutual Aid Area Emergency Management Organization.
- 9. This Bylaw shall come into force on the day of its final passing.

10. Bylaw No 5/90 is hereby repealed.
