BYLAW NO. 2/89 A BYLAW TO REGULATE ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES.

The council of the Village of Debden in the province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. In this Bylaw:
 - (a) "all terrain vehicle" means all terrain vehicle as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act.
 - (b) "Crown Land" means Crown Land as defined in The Highway Traffic Act.
 - (c) "highway" means a highway as defined in The Highway Traffic Act.
 - (d) "private land" means land other than public land.
 - (e) "public land" means public land as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act.
 - (f) "vehicle" means a vehicle as defined in The Highway Traffic Act.
- 2. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any private property within the corporate limits of the Village of Debden unless permission of the owner is obtained.
- 3. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any public property within the corporate limits of the Village of Debden.
- 4. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any Crown Land.
- 5. A person is authorized to operate an all terrain vehicle on any highway within the Village of Debden.
