

BYLAW NO: 5190

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF DEBDEN, BEING A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION.

THE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF DEBDEN IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN DO HEREBY, ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. THE COUNCIL SHALL ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY MEASURE ORGANIZATION TO DEAL WITH ANY EMERGENCY OR DISASTER; THAT MAY OCCUR.
2. THE ORGANIZATION SHALL CONSIST OF TWO BRANCHES:
 - (A) THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SHALL CONSIST OF ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL. THIS COMMITTEE SHALL ESTABLISH POLICY FOR THE EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION AND APPOINT A COORDINATOR FOR THE ORGANIZATION.
 - (B) THE PLANNING COMMITTEE SHALL CONSIST OF OFFICERS OF THE VILLAGE OF DEBDEN AND SUCH OTHER PERSONS AS DEEMED NECESSARY. THE PLANNING COMMITTEE, UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF THE COORDINATOR SHALL FORMULATE A MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY PLAN.
3. THE VILLAGE OF DEBDEN SHALL PROVIDE FUNDING AS DEEMED NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE IN THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION.
4. THE COUNCIL MAY COOPERATE WITH THE COUNCILS OF OTHER MUNICIPALITIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF JOINTLY ESTABLISHING AND OPERATING A MUTUAL AID AREA EMERGENCY ORGANIZATION.
