BYLAW NO. 8 - 2003

A Bylaw to provide for entering into an Inter-municipal Agreement to create a corporation for the construction, renovation or acquisition and the operation and maintenance of certain property and equipment for a landfill operation.

The Council of the Village of Debden, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Village of Debden is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement, attached hereto and forming a part of this Bylaw and identified as Exhibit "A", with:
 - (a) The Rural Municipality of Canwood No. 494
 - (b) The Village of Canwood

for the purpose stated within the Agreement.

THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH as follows:

(a) The Highway 55 Waste Management Corporation, a duly incorporated corporation to operate a landfill within the boundaries of the Rural Municipality of Canwood No. 494.

(b) Capital Contribution Breakdown:

- The Rural Municipality of Canwood No. 494 agrees to contribute 60% of the capital cost of this facility.
- (2) The Village of Debden agrees to contribute 20% of the capital cost of this facility.
- (3) The Village of Canwood agrees to contribute 20% of the capital cost of this facility.

(c) Initial Operation and Maintenance Costs Contribution Breakdown:

- The Rural Municipality of Canwood No. 494 agrees to contribute 60% of the initial operation and maintenance costs of this facility.
- (2) The Village of Debden agrees to contribute 20% of the initial operation and maintenance costs of this facility.
- (3) The Village of Canwood agrees to contribute 20% of the initial operation and maintenance costs of this facility.

(d) Voting Control of the Corporation:

- The Rural Municipality of Canwood No. 494 is to have a 50% interest in the voting control of the corporation.
- (2) The Village of Debden is to have a 25% interest in the voting control of the corporation.
- (3) The Village of Canwood is to have a 25% interest in the voting control of the corporation.
