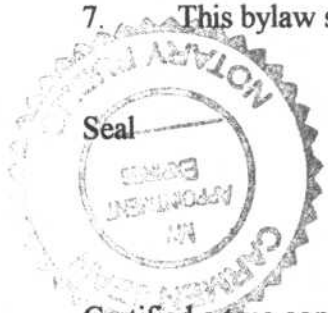
Bylaw Number: 4/2004

A Weight Restriction Bylaw

A Bylaw of the Village of Debden in the Province of Saskatchewan to regulate the weight of vehicles.

The Council for the Village of Debden, in the Province of Saskatchewan in open meeting hereby enacts as follows:

1. That no person shall operate a vehicle or a combination of vehicles or park on any street, when the combined gross weight of the vehicles(s) with or without a load exceeds 8,500 kg, except on a highway within the municipality designated as a Heavy Vehicle Route as listed in Appendix 1.
2. Sections (1) shall not apply to vehicles making deliveries, school buses, municipal equipment, non licensed farm equipment for the purpose of service or fueling, or recreational vehicles on any highway in the municipality provided that the operator of the vehicle(s) use the most direct route from and to the Heavy Vehicle Route, as listed in Appendix 1.
3. Notwithstanding Section (2), the operator of the vehicles is responsible for any road damage caused when making such delivery.
4. The provisions of The Police Act and The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997 shall apply to the operators of vehicles referred to in Sections (1) and (2).
5. A person who contravenes the provisions of Section (1) and (2) is guilty of an offense and liable on summary conviction to a penalty of \$1,000.00.
7. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of approval by council.
