BYLAW NO 4/2016

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PROPERTY TAX PENALTIES

The Council of the Village of Debden in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Due Date

Property and other taxes imposed by the Village of Debden are deemed to be imposed on the first day of January in each year and shall be due on December 31 of that year.

- 2. Penalty on Arrears of Taxes
 - a) Taxes which remain unpaid after the 31st day of December of the year in which they are levied shall be subject to a penalty.
 - b) The method of calculating the penalty shall be a simple rate of 10% per annum, added on January 1st applied to the total taxes that remain unpaid as at January 1 of the year in which the penalty is being applied.
 - c) The penalty charges are to be added to and shall form part of the tax roll.
- 3. All previous bylaws regarding tax penalties are repealed.

This bylaw will come into effect on the date of final approval of Council.
