Running for Municipal Office

Why should I run for elected municipal office?

As an elected official, you will:

- commit to making a regular contribution to your community
- influence changes that benefit your community and ensure its sustainability
- put forward new ideas for debate and possible implementation and change
- make a positive difference in the quality of life in your community
- provide a voice for your community with other levels of government
- be a part of a team that makes decisions that impact your entire municipality
- maintain and improve economic and social opportunities in your municipality.

Am I qualified to be an elected official?

The Local Government Election Act (LGEA) provides the requirements for candidates in municipal elections.

In the case of town, village and city elections, a person is qualified if:

- on the day of election is 18 years of age **and**
- at the time of submission of the nomination paper, is a Canadian citizen **and**
- has resided in the municipality for at least 3 consecutive months and in Saskatchewan for at least 6 consecutive months immediately preceding the date the nomination form is submitted **and**
- is not disqualified pursuant to any provision in the LGEA or any other Act.
