Tree Maintenance

Property owners are responsible for ensuring trees and shrubs on their property do not hang over the streets, back alleys and sidewalks and also to ensure that branches are not near power lines or interfering on neighboring properties.

Property owners are responsible for all Fire Department costs if they are called out for a fire sparked by electrical lines. When branches are near or touching a power line, contact SaskPower for a Tree Trimming Assessment. A link to the Assessment Request is available on our website, or

Tag-A-Bag

Each property is permitted one free bag of garbage per week. Additional bags must be clearly tagged, with tags available at the Village Office and the Comité Culturel Office. Residents are kindly reminded to ensure all garbage is placed in a secure, covered bin to prevent access by birds and wildlife.

Contact Information and Village Alert System

Are you new to Debden or has your contact information changed? If there is an emergency with your property or within the Village, do we have the information on file to contact you? The Village uses a mass messaging system to alert residents for situations such as boil water advisories and emergency events. Notifications can be delivered to you by email, phone or text. If you haven't provided this information to the office, or if you have changed phone numbers or discontinued your land line please update your information by contacting the Village Office or by using the Telmatik mass messaging link on our website, debden.ca.

Zoning & Building Bylaws

The Zoning and Building Bylaws require that "every person before commencing any development or use within the Village" shall obtain a Development permit. This includes decks, garages, sheds, any new construction and renovations that may affect load bearing walls, and any change of use of a building or space. Permits are also required for buildings being moved into or out of the Village including sheds, garages and seacans (only permitted in C2 district).

Applications are presented for approval at Regular Council meetings only. Please take this into consideration when submitting an application. A reminder that all contractors you hire to conduct any work on your home or yard are required to have a Business License.
