VILLAGE OF DEBDEN POLICY REGARDING RESIDENTIAL WATER AND SEWER SERVICE LINES (i.e. Lines from Main to Pasidence)

(i.e. Lines from Main to Residence)

The Council for the Village of Debden Sets the following policy on residential water and sewer service lines (i.e. lines from main to house):

In regards to sewer service lines: The owner is responsible for the installation of such lines from the main to the residence. The owner is also responsible for any repair to any sewer service line –i.e. blockages, breakage, collapses. The Village is only responsible for the main sewer line.

<u>In regards to Water Lines</u>: The owner is responsible for the installation of such lines from the main to the residence. The Village will provide the curb stop that is required to be installed at the edge of the property. After installation, the Village will assume responsibility for the line from the main line to the edge of the property. The resident will be responsible from the edge of the property to the residence.

Other:

Policy 1-2014

- The contractor doing the work must be approved by the Village of Debden and/or can be arranged by the Village of Debden.
- The contractor must bill the Village of Debden for the work done and the Village will then bill the resident.
- The repair must be okayed by the Village Maintenance Foreman before it is back filled.
- If the required, the Village Maintenance Foreman will be available for assistance at no extra cost to the resident.
- The Village will provide all the material for the backfilling of the trench and for any repairs to refinishing the street and any repairs to the sidewalks.
