Purpose

To clarify and prioritize, within budget limitations, the areas in which dust control suppressants may be applied on Municipal controlled roadways in ongoing efforts to ensure public safety, quality of life, and to realize road maintenance cost reductions as well as to establish guidelines for residents applying for dust suppressant application.

Scope

Dust control is meant to control dust on roadways, not to eliminate it completely. The decision to proceed with dust control will be made on an annual basis during budget discussion.

Policy

- 1. In budgeted years, if determined required, dust control suppressant will be applied to the following locations as shown on the attached map, Schedule A.
 - 1st Avenue East from Main Street to end of Municipal Boundary line (known as Heavy Haul Route)
 - 1st Avenue West from Main Street to the hydrant at end of Lot 13 Block 10 Plan 102249288 (known as Heavy Haul Route)
 - Main Street from 4th Avenue to 5th Avenue or to Debden Cemetery
- 2. The type of dust control suppressant utilized will be determined by Council. In its sole discretion; however, consideration will be given to cost of application, durability/effectiveness, and environmental safety issues.
- 3. No resident shall apply dust control products to any municipal controlled streets without first obtaining permission from the Village Office to ensure roads are thoroughly prepped for application.

- 4. The Village Foreman will determine the appropriate timing to apply the dust control suppressants.
- 5. There will be no reimbursement of costs given to any resident for dust control application done on their own accord.
