RE: Rescinding of Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory

Dear Mayor & Council,

This letter is to advise that the Water Security Agency (WSA) in consultation with the Saskatchewan Health Authority has, by way of this letter, rescinded the Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory (PDWA) issued to the Village of Debden Waterworks on April 17, 2020. This advisory was issued in response to a water main break causing a depressurization and has been rescinded based on the fulfillment of rescinding conditions.

Please issue immediate notice to the public of the rescinding of the advisory. Further, the waterworks may return to its regular sampling intervals. If a positive sample is realized upon immediate return to regular sampling submission, the Water Security Agency may, if believed necessary, consider the issuance of a new PDWA.
