- 1. Lowest tender not necessarily accepted.
- 2. <u>All</u> shuttle drivers will be required to have valid drivers license. A package policy with liability coverage for evening transport vehicles is recommended.
- 3. Successful Tender will be responsible for the following:
 - Providing taxi shuttle for SGI's "Safe Ride Home" Friday, Saturday and Sunday evenings from 7:00 p.m. – 2:30 a.m. within 5 km radius of Debden.
 - Modes of transportation and fuel are supplied by tender applicant. Vehicles must have valid registered plates.
- 4. It will be advertised in the program that the fees are paid by the Centennial Committee but that riders are welcome to leave the driver/group a gratuity.
- 5. This service is sponsored by SGI's Safe Ride Home. There is zero-tolerance for any alcohol or substance use for drivers who are awarded the tender. The driver's are responsible to ensure they are a Safe Ride home for everyone that uses this service.

Tender bids should include the following information:

Specify if you are tendering on behalf of a non-profit group or if your tender is for profit.

Specify how many people will be actively working within this group and who will be supervising if it is a non-profit group.

Specify the modes of shuttle you will be providing and how many will be available for transportation.

This is tendered as a full weekend event. Your tender bid should take into consideration the hours of the event.
